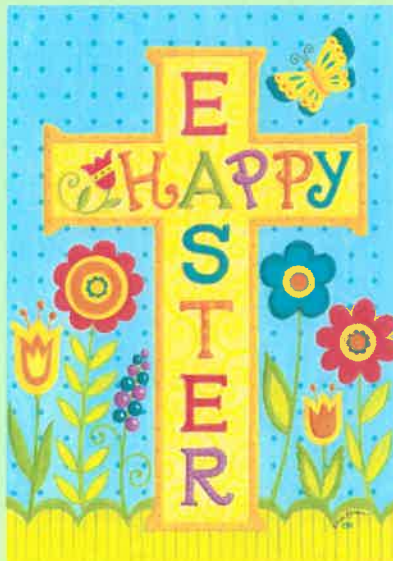
Positive Addiction Race Volunteers Needed:

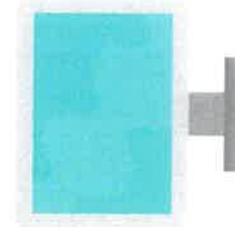

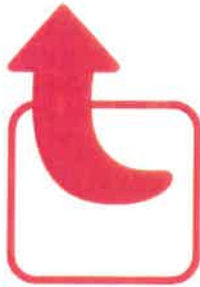
