### Positive Addiction Week:

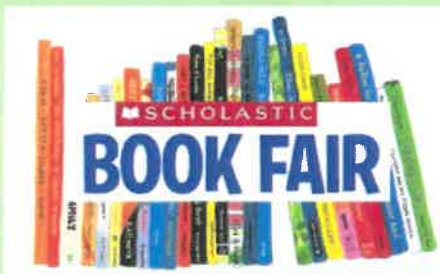
Thank you to everyone that assisted with Positive Addiction Week. We appreciate all the parents and other family members that have volunteered to drive our students throughout this week.
